Beginnings and Endings

The month of January is named after Janus, the Roman god of beginnings and endings, doors, and transitions. Janus is often depicted with two faces, one looking forward and the other backward, to represent his ability to see both the past and the future. Janus presided over doors and gates, which is appropriate for the new year.

The new year, for many, is a time for reflection of the past year, and for some a time to make resolutions for the coming year. Our congregation is now in a time of transition with the end of the ministry of Pastor Monica, and the beginning of the journey toward the next chapter of our ministry.

On December 19, 2024, the Immanuel Council members and the Board of Lutheran Episcopal Campus Ministry (LECM) met with Bishop Meghan Johnston Aelabouni and Pastor Deb Abbott, one of the deans for the North Colorado Conference, to which our congregation belongs. Those attending shared our affirmations of Pastor Monica's two ministries in Greeley and Pastor Monica gave her reflections of each ministry.

Pastor Deb Abbott gave an overview of the North Colorado Conference, comprising of 10 congregations. She expressed support from the other pastors in the conference but also mentioned that a few other congregations in our conference are also in transition.

Immanuel and LECM have been assigned a transition coach – someone who will be our first point of contact during the transition and call process. As we move through these next weeks and months, the Council will keep the congregation informed along the way. If you have questions, please ask, but understand that there may not be an answer just yet. In the meantime, we ask for your prayers, patience and support.


